A : Qualification Criteria, 6.1 A) Manufacturer Bidders, (a) Financial Capability

The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following financial requirement(s): The bidders who are also the manufacturers, should have average annual sales turnover of minimum of Five (5) times the quoted value of the Goods during the last five years to qualify for one schedule. To qualify for multiple schedules the turnover requirement shall be the sum of requirements against individual schedule. Of the total revenue generated the minimum share of at least 20% to be derived from Non-Bank financed contracts	The Bidder shall furnish documentary evidence that it meets the following financial requirement(s): The bidders who are also the manufacturers, should have average annual sales turnover of minimum of Three (3) times the quoted value of the Goods during the last five years to qualify for one schedule. To qualify for multiple schedules the turnover requirement shall be the sum of requirements against individual schedule. Of the total revenue generated the minimum share of at least 20% to be derived from Non-Bank financed contracts
3. Section IV: Special Conditions of Contract, 10. Warranty (GCC Clause 15)	
Add the following at the end of clause 10	
NOTE: The Warranty and CMC services are to be provided by the supplier at the places where the equipments will finally be installed.	

All other terms & conditions of the original bid document shall remain unaltered.
