The Government of India has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the Second National Tuberculosis Control Project, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for procurement of Anti TB Drugs. This contract will be jointly financed by the Global Funds to fight HIV/AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (GFATM). The United Nations Office for Project Services (UNOPS), New Delhi, India now on behalf of The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for procurement of-

Bidding will be conducted through the international competitive bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's [Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits](#), (current edition), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the guidelines.

Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from and inspect the bidding documents from the (UNOPS) at the address below during office hours(1000 to 1700 hours). A complete set of bidding documents in English may be purchased by interested bidders on the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of Rs. 4300 or US \$100 from 19th July 2007 till 1400hrs of 3rd September 2007. The method of payment will be by Demand Draft/Cashier's Cheque/Certified Cheque in favour of UNDP payable at New Delhi. The document will be sent by courier on payment of an additional amount of Rs. 500 for domestic bidder and US \$ 50 for overseas bidder if requested by mail. The Bid documents can also be viewed at websites www.unops.org and www.tbcindia.org. Cost towards the bid documents downloaded, shall be deposited at the time of bid submission.

All bids must be accompanied by a bid security as indicated in the bid document and be delivered to the address below by 1400 Hrs(IST) on 3rd September 2007. They will be opened immediately thereafter, in the presence of bidders' representatives, who choose to attend, at the address below. Late bids will be rejected.
